#### A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ALEX:

It's always nice when Easter falls in April instead of March (and as the lady who prepares my tax returns told me, it's even better when Easter comes after April 15<sup>th</sup>! She also happens to be a church organist so I think we can all appreciate her point!) I know I much prefer a later Easter. The days are longer, the weather is warmer, the egg hunts are better, and most of the flowers are in full bloom. Signs of new and abundant life abound as we come to worship and celebrate the good news of the empty tomb!

And yet, as Holy Week poignantly reminds us, before there can be resurrection and shouts of "Alleluia", there must first be death and the cross. The season of Lent is a time for many matters under heaven as Ecclesiastes would put it, and these 40 days have certainly provided us with a roadmap for the journey. We know *who* we are following and *where* we are going. The destination is inevitable. Calvary is just ahead.

We will begin on Palm Sunday with a procession and palms as we give all glory, laud, and honor to our Redeemer King and his triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The ringing of our sweet "Hosannas" will quickly cease when we read the Passion of our Lord according to Luke, which will prepare us for the week ahead.

Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services will both begin at 7:30pm. Our Maundy Thursday worship will include a time for handwashing and Holy Communion before we strip the altar and listen to the words of Psalm 22. On Good Friday, we will hear the story of our Lord's Passion according to St. John as together we behold the savior of the world and reflect on the glory of the cross.

Finally, join us on Easter Sunday at 9:30am when we celebrate the paramount event of our Christian faith: the Resurrection of Christ. An Easter egg hunt will immediately follow the service outside in the Memorial Garden (hopefully we are blessed with a beautiful sunny morning!), and then we will be sent out to share the good news of the day: "Christ is Risen! He is Risen, Indeed! Alleluia!"

#### ST. JOHN-INCARNATION HYMN TOURNAMENT



Our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual hymn tournament concluded on Sunday, April 7 with a surprising championship matchup between two rather unexpected hymns: "We Are Called" vs. "This Little Light of Mine." The competition picked up in the final round and the donations increased significantly, but when it was all said and done, the winning hymn for 2019 was the #16 seeded, "We Are Called."

As our new champion, "We Are Called" (ELW #720) will be sung once a month in worship for the next year. Our runner—up, "This Little Light of Mine" will be sung quarterly (4x) and the other two hymns of the Final 4—"I Love to Tell the Story" and "How Great Thou Art"—will be sung three extra times over the next year.
