# **PASTOR'S REPORT FOR 2018**

2018 was a monumental year for St. John–Incarnation Lutheran Church. We said goodbye to the Cedarhurst building with a final closing worship service in March, and on February 22<sup>nd</sup> our merger was officially approved by the state of New York. With the merger completed, we were able to better focus on our ministries and devote more time and energy to outreach, and as you will see in the following committee reports, God helped us accomplish a whole lot during our first year together as a new congregation!

#### Some highlights of 2018 include:

- VBS! Definitely my favorite one yet! 27 children joined us in August for "Hero Central" where we discovered our strength in God and learned about the qualities and attributes that truly make us God's heroes. Plus, we all got to wear capes, myself included! Many thanks to Gabrielle Barry for serving once again as co-director!
- Our second annual March Madness Hymn Tournament, which raised a total of \$570 (up \$50 from the first year) for our Christian Education ministries. The winning hymn was "Christ, Be Our Light" and the runner-up was "The Old Rugged Cross."
- Giving out "Ashes to Go" again at the Lynbrook train station on Ash Wednesday. This year, the Rev. Lynn Collins of St. John the Evangelist helped me give ashes to about 60-70 people. Folks are definitely on the lookout now!
- Our summer Bible study series on the formation and evolution of the Bible. We looked at the history of the Bible as a text and how it became the book we know today, from oral traditions to manuscripts to print.
- Planting the SJILC Welcome Garden behind the parsonage with our Sunday school kids and youth.

On a personal note, my ministry in 2018 included a few firsts that were incredibly special. I had the honor of baptizing my cousin's twins at my home church in Pennsylvania (relative, twins, home church – all firsts!). I officiated the wedding of my best friend who I've known since elementary school, and I performed a vow renewal ceremony on a yacht! All three were amazing experiences that I will never forget.

I started using the Parish Resource Center in Valley Stream, and it quickly became my go-to place for all things ministry and church. The PRC provided me with a variety of great resources for confirmation, stewardship, Sunday School, and my own continuing education.

Speaking of continuing, I continue to serve as a chaplain for the Lynbrook fire and police departments (although, I have yet to do anything in an official capacity for the police), and I also continue to attend monthly Ministerium meetings with my fellow colleagues in the SW Nassau Conference of the Metro NY Synod.

Many thanks to our devoted staff and dedicated leaders, especially our Council President, Richard Dietrich, and the members of our Congregational Council. I'm very fortunate to work with Andrea Sommella, Allison Koehler, and Judy Pang, and our congregation is truly blessed to have them! I also want to thank Jeanette Richetti for starting the Yoga classes on Monday nights. Her classes have been a wonderful new ministry for our church! Thank you to Gabrielle Barry for leading our Sunday School program again and for the parents who helped teach our children. A special thank you to Katharine Forte for not only helping me with the Confirmation class again this year, but also for her willingness to preach and supply for me when I'm away. Finally, thanks be to God for each and every one of you – for your love, your generosity, your faithfulness, your prayers, and your support these last 12 months.

We will have some important decisions to make in 2019, but we know that God will be with us in our discerning and deciding. May God continue to bless the congregation of St. John–Incarnation as we follow Christ and do God's work in the year ahead!

# IT'S TOURNAMENT TIME!

In the spirit of next month's college basketball tournaments, we will be having our 3<sup>rd</sup> annual hymn tournament here at St. John-Incarnation! Last year's "Musical Madness" was filled with shocking upsets with the top *eight* seeds (including the defending champion, "Here I am, Lord") all failing to reach the Final 4. The championship featured the #9 seed, "Christ, Be Our Light" vs. the #10 seed, "The Old Rugged Cross" with "Christ, Be Our Light" taking the title at the buzzer.

Will "Christ, Be Our Light" repeat and make it two in a row? Or will this be the year that "A Mighty Fortress" finally wins it all? Here's your chance to once again support your favorite hymns and root them on to victory!

A reminder of the rules and format: Please submit your favorite hymn(s) that you would like entered into the tournament by no later than **Friday, March 15**<sup>th</sup>. The 16 hymns that have the most nominations will qualify with seeding determined by number of submissions. When you arrive at church on Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup> you will find 16 cups on a table placed in pairs. Each cup will have the name of a hymn on it, and matchups will be based on seeding just like the college basketball tournament (#1 vs. #16, #2 vs. #15, etc.)

Voting will be done each round/week by donations – loose change, cash, or checks made out to St. John-Incarnation Lutheran Church. The cup that has more money in each pairing at the end of the morning will be the hymn that moves on to the next round:  $16 \rightarrow 8 \rightarrow 4 \rightarrow 2 \rightarrow 1$














# FASTNACHT MAKING FUN!
