A message from Pastor Alex:

"Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven." We hear these words from Matthew's gospel every time we celebrate a baptism here at St. John–Incarnation just as they were spoken to us on the day we were baptized. But where does this light come from? How do we let it shine? What fuels it?

As the days get shorter and darkness takes over in these autumn months, we know that winter is well on its way. Very soon we will hear once again in Advent the prophet Isaiah who declares, "The people walking in darkness have seen a great light... on them light has shined." This great light, of course, is none other than our Lord Jesus Christ, the one who called Himself the light of the world and who has given us His light in the waters of baptism. Through this most gracious gift, our baptismal liturgy reminds us that "we are united with all the baptized in the one body of Christ, anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and joined in God's mission for the life of the world."

Mission is at the heart of all we do at St. John-Incarnation Lutheran Church. It guides our ministries, our programs, and most importantly our outreach to our community and beyond. Thus, our stewardship committee has decided that the theme for our annual appeal this year will be "May Our Light So Shine." The program will kick off on Sunday, October 28th (Reformation Sunday – don't forget to wear your red!) with a thanksgiving for baptism at the beginning of both services and a luncheon afterwards at 11:00am. The menu will include a variety of delicious German foods and of course some good "Lutheran beverage" as I like to call it. Updates on the budget, roof appeal, etc. will also be given during the meal so please join us! The program will conclude on Sunday, November 18th with a special time during worship for giving commitments cards while *many* additional candles are lit. You will definitely want to see the sanctuary that morning!

Letters and commitment cards will be sent out to all members in the coming days with more information about our appeal. As always, thank you for your continued support of this congregation. Your generous gifts of your time, talents, and monetary donations allow us to do God's work and help those in need. Together we sing and pray, "Christ, be our light! Shine in our hearts. Shine through the darkness. Christ, be our light! Shine in your church gathered today."

St. John-Incarnation Lutheran Church Roof Fund Appeal

The Stewardship and Finance committee is pleased to let you know the work on the roof above the old church which is above the knotty pine room, church office, council room and nursery is almost done. Unfortunately, there was unforeseen water damage to the roof that had to be addressed. We will need \$6,000.00 more to cover the work that needed to be done. We are still collecting funds to cover the cost.

We were awarded a Congregational Capital Improvement Challenge Grant from the Metropolitan New York Synod Council for \$9,000. We had \$5,000 left over from the air conditioner fund which was transferred to the roof fund. We also had a very generous offer from someone who was willing to match dollar-for-dollar every donation that was made to our roof fund up to \$5,000.00. We have met that goal.

Thank you to all who have so generously contributed to this appeal! With the additional work that was needed to be done, it is our hope and prayer that you will consider making a donation to this new roof.


