A Message from Pastor Alex...

Even though the 500th anniversary of the Reformation is still over four months away, the celebration has already begun here at St. John's as we prepare to commemorate one of the most important events in the history of the church. We started a few weeks ago with the "Here I Stand" Martin Luther standees, which are still available in the narthex for your taking (there are about 10 left, but we can easily get more!). Many of you have already snapped and submitted photos with Luther in your travels. THANK YOU! We will be posting these photos in upcoming editions of the Messenger as well as the bulletin board in the narthex. The more pictures we get, the better, so please keep sending them in!

Our summer Bible study series will also focus on Luther and the Reformation with a book entitled <u>Together by Grace: Introducing the Lutherans</u>. Written by Lutheran pastors, scholars, and other leaders within the church specifically for the 500th anniversary, this new publication from Augsburg Fortress shares many stories of Lutheran faith and mission throughout the past five centuries while at the same time looking to the future. We will begin on **Wednesday, July 12 at 7:00pm** and then meet the next five Wednesdays (7/19, 7/26, 8/2, 8/9, and 8/16) for a total of six sessions. If you are interested in joining us, please contact the church office or sign up in the narthex by **Sunday, July 2nd** so that we have time to order the books. The cost of the book is \$10 unless you want to buy it yourself, which you are more than welcome to do.

Finally, from now until October 29th we will be selling "Reformation 500" magnets (pictured lower left) on Sunday mornings and during other events. The magnets are only \$1 each and with that you will ALSO get a free placemat (pictured lower right) with some of Luther's table prayers and one of his hymns. Both items are a great way for you and your family to honor Martin Luther and get ready for the big celebration come Reformation Sunday!

These are just a few of the many things that we will be doing in the coming months leading up to the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. As we announced in the previous edition of the Messenger, our Vacation Bible School theme for this summer will be "Mighty Fortress." (You can probably guess at least one song the kids will be learning that week!)


We will also have a congregational viewing of Rick Steves' one-hour PBS special on Martin Luther and the Reformation, which will take place either in September or early October.


















WHERE IN THE WORLD IS MARTIN LUTHER?
