A Message from the Pastor...

Sing to the LORD a new song, for he has done marvelous things. By the power of his right hand and his holy arm, he has saved his people. Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth, break forth into jubilant song and sing praises. Sing praises to the LORD with the harp, with the harp and the sound of melody, with trumpets and the sound of the horn make a joyful noise before the King, the LORD. ~ Psalm 98:1, 4–6

If you joined us for worship on Christmas Eve, you got to hear some very special music at the beginning of the service. Kaylee Palmer sang a beautiful a capella rendition of "O Holy Night." Parker Sloan played an awesome violin medley with our organist, Judy Markson, accompanying him on the piano. And speaking of our new piano, we were even blessed with an incredible duet by Judy and her husband, Oliver, played in four—hand! What a wonderful way to begin our celebration of Christ's birth! What a holy night, indeed!

Yes, we certainly love to sing and make a joyful noise to the Lord here at St. John–Incarnation Lutheran Church. We love singing our favorite hymns in worship like "A Mighty Fortress," "Christ, Be Our Light," and "We Are Called." We enjoy singing the various parts of the liturgy each Sunday like the Kyrie, Gospel Acclamation, Lamb of God, etc. Our church choir sings an anthem as the Table is prepared for Communion, and our carillon rings sweetly as we enter the church.

Martin Luther believed that music was one of God's greatest gifts: "Next to the Word of God, music deserves the highest praise." He argued that music not only "puts to flight every spirit of sadness" and "drives away the devil and makes people cheerful," but it also has the power to bring us closer to God and make the words of scripture come to life. This was especially true with respect to singing as Luther once said, "He who is singing has no quarrel with the world and is not concerned with contentions in a law court. Singers are neither worried nor sad but shake all cares from their souls."

So if you're like me and you love to sing, perhaps you might consider joining our church choir? We are always seeking new members (especially men!) and you do not have to read music or even be a good singer in order to join. After all, the Psalmist tells us to make a joyful noise to the Lord, but that doesn't mean it has to be a beautiful one! All singing is pleasing to God. Or maybe this is the year that we start a children's choir? We definitely have some talented young singers in our congregation and the Sunday School Christmas pageant last month was further proof of that. Do you or your child play an instrument? Come and share a song in worship! Judy will be more than happy to help and provide accompaniment if needed.

May God bless our music and ministry as together we sing to the LORD a new song in 2020.
