A Message from Pastor Alex:

Happy New Year, church! 2021 is now behind us and 2022 is here! Thanks be to God!

It's hard to believe that we're *still* dealing with Covid two years later, and while I really hoped and prayed that somehow everything would be resolved by now, unfortunately the virus remains and this Omicron variant is really getting around! Therefore, we will continue to be very cautious here at SJILC by wearing our masks, using pre-filled Communion cups, sharing the Peace from six feet away, and having hand sanitizer available throughout the building, among other precautions. If you're not feeling well or experiencing any cold or flu-like symptoms, please, please, PLEASE stay home and join us on Zoom instead. I know it's not the same as coming to church and being in the sanctuary with your fellow sisters and brothers, but you can still worship and be present with us remotely that day, and more importantly, you'll be helping us keep everyone as safe as possible. Thank you once again for your cooperation and understanding!

Yes, we have been through a lot these past 22 months and obviously life isn't the same as it was at the start of 2020. People are still getting sick and dying, which is disheartening enough, especially after we were told that the vaccines would prevent us from getting infected and mitigate the spread. 
