† PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Throughout the season of Easter, we'll be using the "Thanksgiving for Baptism" rather than the "Confession and Forgiveness" at the beginning of worship. We've done this for a season or two in the past, and I've had people who were curious about it.

"Don't we need to confess, Pastor?" or "Pastor, I need that time for confession...."

Of course we need to confess. We need to repent daily, to be always turning back to God. We need to be trying to live a life that says "Yes" to God instead of rebelling, and confession helps us to do this.

The reality is that confession, along with the repentance that leads us to confession, is tied to the waters of baptism. Martin Luther said, "What is repentance but an earnest attack on the old creature and an entering into a new life? If you live in repentance, therefore, you are walking in baptism, which not only announces this new life, but also produces, begins, and

exercises it. In baptism, we are given the grace, Spirit, and strength to suppress the old creature so that the new may come forth and grow strong." (The Book of Concord, p. 466.75)

When we return to the waters of our baptism, we remember that we are joined with Christ forever. We rejoice in God's gift of mercy and forgiveness. That's why I always lead the confession standing by the font. It is in God's baptismal waters that we hear God's words of forgiveness and God's promise of new life.

In this joyous season of Easter, let us give thanks for the gift of baptism, remembering that we are a people of a resurrection faith and hope, because our sins have been washed away. Thanks be to God!
