WELCA THANKOFFERING SERVICE

The Ladies of Incarnation participate each year in a WELCA Thankoffering service.

Each year the ladies participate in all aspects of the worship service. This year Pastor Noto led us with a meaningful sermon. All year we collect coins and cash in a long standing tradition dating back to the 1800s, when Christian women formed "mite" or "cent" societies to fund mission. When others in the church said there was not enough money to carry out these projects, the women believed otherwise. In these societies, each woman collected offerings at home.

On occasion, they would gather as we do today to worship and combine their offerings and offer them up with thanks and praise. When Women of the ELCA was formed nearly 30 years ago, we committed to continue this tradition of giving in gratitude for blessings. Each year, in thousands of congregations, Thankofferings are collected and sent to support the life-changing ministries of Women of the ELCA. Together, we do more than we could ever do apart. In gratitude for all God has given to us, and with hope for all that is to come LINCS continues this tradition.
