Le Nozze di Figaro is the story of Figaro, his fiancée Susanna, his master the Count, the Countess, and the pageboy, Cherubino. When the Count Almaviva poses a threat to Figaro's impending wedding, all bets are off in this famous Mozart comedy set to a sparkling libretto by Lorenzo da Ponte.

The concert will feature **Dmitry Glivinskiy** on piano, **Devony Smith** as Susanna, **Michael Maliakel** as Figaro, **Jaimie Appleton** as Countess Almaviva, **Michael Hoffman** as Count Almaviva, **Kimberly Feltkamp** as Cherubino, **Maayan Voss de Bettancourt** as Marcellina, and others.
