From the Desk of Pastor Alex:

Summer always seems to be the slowest time of the year when it comes to the church. There are no major festivals or liturgical celebrations. Sunday School, confirmation, and choir are all off until September. Families go on vacation, kids are away at camp, and worship attendance goes down. It's almost like the church's "off-season" as we take our proverbial foot off the gas pedal and cruise for a few months.

Well I'm here to tell you that St. John's is NOT going on vacation this summer! We have a number of exciting things happening in the coming weeks and I would like to highlight just a few.

- The early service is back! Starting Sunday, June 28, we will have worship at 8:15am in addition to our regular 9:30am service. This early service will be shorter and the liturgy will be spoken rather than sung using *Responsive Prayer*, which is found in our hymnal. Aside from that, everything will be similar to the 9:30 service: scripture, preaching, prayer, Eucharist, etc. Concerned about the heat? No need to worry! Our new air conditioning system will keep you cool and comfortable ;-)
- 2. Food, fun, and fellowship. We have two awesome outdoor events this summer that you should mark on your calendar: WELCA's annual barbeque and St. John's Adult Night Out. Details for both can be found in this month's Messenger. We also have a few extra tickets for the Long Island Ducks game on Friday, July 31st at 6:30pm. These will go pretty quickly so if you're interested, please call the church office. Tickets are just \$12 for a night to enjoy some great baseball in the company of church friends. Doesn't get much better than that!
- 3. Vacation Bible School is happening again! Yes, apparently the word got out about our Jungle Safari VBS because we're already receiving calls from new folks who are asking about this summer! Praise God! This year's theme is going to be "Bible Blast to the Past" where we will travel back to biblical times to discover God's amazing and everlasting love. The program, which will take place on the weeknights of August 24-28, is for children 6th grade and under, but we will be looking for adults AND youth to help out. This is an easy way to get some community service hours and it's a lot of fun.
- **4. Weekly Bible Study.** Starting June 17 at 7:00pm, we will have a Wednesday night Bible study in the council room. I have a few ideas for us to start off with (for example, comparing the best-seller "Heaven is for Real" with the book of Revelation), but I'm open to anything and everything so if there is a particular theme or book in the Bible that you would like to study, please let me know.




