A Message from Pastor Alex:

We often think of spring as the season of growth and new life, and rightly so. The trees begin to bud, flowers are in bloom, and before we know it, everything that was so dull and bare for so long is suddenly green, lush, and brimming with life! Indeed, once the birds return and start singing God's praises in the morning, we know that spring is on the way!

Well, the good Lord has certainly given us another beautiful spring here in New York. We've had plenty of rain, and for the most part, temperatures have been ideal. Frankly, I'd be quite content with 80 degrees from now until September, but given that I'll be in New Orleans later this month, the rest of the summer shouldn't feel too bad! I was actually there 10 years ago for the ELCA National Youth Gathering, which was held in July, and let me tell you, that's a different kind of heat and humidity down south!

Yes, summer is almost here (officially it will begin on June 21st), and for many of us that means vacations, camps, pool days, and lots of beach time! I'll admit, I do miss those long summer breaks that I enjoyed when I was a student. No school or homework. Just eight weeks of "freedom" and time spent with family and friends.

Summer is also the season when our church vegetable garden really takes off and begins to produce! Having done this for a few years now, I've seen firsthand that growth doesn't stop when spring ends. It may slow down a bit when the rain tapers off and the heat kicks in, and if we happen to have a drought and the plants don't get watered, obviously they can die.

But that's where you and I come in. Whether it's a garden, a flowerbed, the grass and trees, or even just a single house plant, we know how vital water and sunlight are, and fortunately for us (and for all living things!), our gracious and loving God provides the earth with plenty of both for our survival. Now why some areas experience phenomena like droughts and flooding is a question I don't have the answer to. Extreme weather and natural disasters have been occurring for thousands of years, and yet it's also pretty evident that we humans have not been good to this world we share.

Either way, God calls us to care for creation and to love all people, even our enemies, for as Jesus says in his Sermon on the Mount, God "makes the sun rise on the evil and on the good and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous." Yes, we all need a little tender love and care! It's necessary for our survival, but it also helps us grow and revives us when we wilt. And so, as Christians, we strive to share that love as much as possible with our words and our actions knowing that we can (and should) love others just as Jesus loves us and all people, especially the poor.

How do we grow in faith and love? Through the gifts of word and sacrament – the primary means by which we receive God's steadfast love. Baptism reminds us that we are truly "walking wet", having been showered with abundant grace and named as God's beloved and redeemed children. We are joined to Christ's death and resurrection at the font and at the table where we are fed with forgiveness in the body and blood of our Lord. Those who do not take Communion and would like to receive the sacrament are invited to attend First Communion classes on July 21st and 28th at 7:00pm. 


