## A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ALEX:

After three long wintry months apart and a lot of prayerful deliberation at our church council meeting last week, I am pleased to announce that we will be reopening our church building for in-person services beginning this Sunday, March 21 at 9:30am. **THANKS BE TO GOD!** 

Now obviously this doesn't mean that everything is back to "normal." Positive cases are still occurring in our area and many people (including myself) have yet to be vaccinated. Therefore, we will continue to follow <u>and enforce</u> all safety guidelines and best practices like before. Temperatures will be taken in the narthex and masks will be required at all times. We will also continue to maintain social distancing with designated pews (a huge thank you to Susan Masciello, Dotty Criscuolo, Cora Sarver, and Joan Pirrone who put up the signs and roped off pews!) and Holy Communion will be distributed outside the front doors immediately following the service. ALL services will continue to be livestreamed on Zoom. <sup>(2)</sup>

It's hard to believe that we're almost through Lent, and yet we know that our call to "return to the Lord your God" remains as together we follow him in faith and love to the cross. Here is the worship schedule for Holy Week 2021:

Palm Sunday (March 28) -9:30amMaundy Thursday (April 1) -7:30pmGood Friday (April 2) -7:30pmEaster Sunday (April 4) -9:30am



As we've done in the past, Palm Sunday will include a reading of the Passion of our Lord (this year it's Mark) with various speaking parts. If you are interested in reading one of the parts, please call or email Andrea in the church office. You don't have to come to church to be a reader! There will be no hand or foot washing on Maundy Thursday, however Holy Communion will be distributed outside after the service. Good Friday will be a Tenebrae service featuring a reading of the Passion according to John.

#### EASTER SUNDAY 2021 AT SJILC

**Plan A:** If the weather is nice (dry <u>and</u> above 60 degrees), Easter worship will take place outside on our church yard. We will have some extra chairs and printed bulletins available if needed, but we kindly ask that you **please bring your own lawn chair and print out your bulletin ahead of time if possible**. You can also view it right on your phone, which saves paper and ink.

**Plan B:** If it's cold and/or rainy, we will move worship into the sanctuary and have everyone who has signed up sitting in designated pews. We will have **24** designated half pews open on the floor level of the sanctuary with each spot being able to seat up to four people (or five if three are smaller children, but just know it might be a little cozy). We will also have a few full pews open up in the balcony for larger families who wish to sit together.

So, for example, if you and your family have seven people coming and we're inside, you'll have two options: you can split up and sit in two separate half pews that are near each other OR you can sit together in a full pew up in the balcony. Just let us know your preference when you RSVP. If you're attending by yourself, you will either get your own half pew or if needed we may even put some individual chairs up front where the two pews were removed last spring. Yes, you'll be in the front (insert Lutheran gasp here), but you will get a nice cushioned chair that's much more comfortable than a pew!

Whether we are inside or outside, reservations for in-person attendance on Easter will be required. We can make some exceptions if we end up worshiping outside where we have more space, but our sanctuary can only hold a certain number of people safely and once we reach capacity that will be it! So if you plan to physically attend church on Easter, make sure to reserve your pew now! Otherwise, we hope you'll watch or listen in on Zoom!

As we look toward reopening our building, ending this virus, and celebrating the good news of Easter, may we remember the words of scripture: "For now the winter is past, the rain is over and gone. The flowers appear on the earth; the time of singing has come." (Song of Solomon 2:11-12)
