The sun is shining as I write these words. It's about 60 degrees outside, and the daffodils, hyacinths, and tulips in front of the church have already begun to sprout and even bloom. However, before you and I can enjoy the new life that comes with springtime and Easter, we know full well that more clouds and rain will come our way. The showers bring the flowers, right? "For everything there is a season," Ecclesiastes tells us, and while Lent is most certainly a season of prayer, fasting, and repentance, it is also a time for us to be forgiven and forgive, trusting that we our watered with God's grace in baptism. We will have our time to laugh and dance when we celebrate the joy of Easter, but now is the time of salvation – a time to weep and mourn and die with our Lord. That being said, we do have the balcony and can always set up more chairs if needed, so please feel free to invite others and/or bring some friends! All children are invited to join us for an Easter egg hunt in the Memorial Garden immediately following the service.

Until then, our Lenten journey continues. We're getting closer, but the destination still awaits. Now is the time to move forward together in faith and in love. Will you join me?
