Grace and peace to you from God our Father and our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

We're now less than a week away from the start of Hometown Nazareth Vacation Bible School, which will be held here at St. John-Incarnation Lutheran Church on August 19, 21, and 23 from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. I'm really excited for this year's theme in which we will explore Jesus' hometown and early life through the eyes of his mother, Mary, and others who knew him as a kid! Children (and adults!) will not only get to visit Mary's house and hear her share some stories from Jesus' childhood, but they will also visit the local marketplace where they will find a carpentry shop, bead bazaar, olive oil shop, rock quarry, food market and more. Add in some new songs, games, and crafts, and it should make for a very fun week! We will learn that just as Jesus had a family, a name, a home, went to church, and served others, we do too! Jesus calls us to follow him in faith as together we look for "God sightings" and share God's love with everyone.

There is a great deal of planning and prep work that goes into our VBS programs, and this summer has been no exception. We've had two meetings and a decorating night thus far, and as you can see in the photos below, our Nazareth is starting to come together! We will finish decorating on Thursday, August 15 at 7:00pm, and, if needed, on Sunday, August 18 after the 9:30am service. If you can give us a few minutes of your time, I would be most grateful!

A few items that we are still looking for include drop cloths, fake fruit, fake palms or other foliage, old brooms, and a 10'x10' pop-up tent. For our mission project during the week, we will be collecting donations of personal care items for the clients of The New LIFE Center. Our VBS co-director, Gabrielle Barry, has already set up a gift list of items on Amazon that The New LIFE Center is requesting. You will see in this Messenger that we even had some extra help filling those backpacks, with Gabrielle Barry bringing some of her students from the Mill Neck Manor School of the Deaf and Karen Feltkamp bringing a group of Girl Scouts to help! What a wonderful way for us to help the New LIFE Center help those in need!

Speaking of backpacks, all students are invited to join us for worship on Sunday, September 8 for a special blessing of book bags and backpacks. September 8 is also our annual day of service – "God's Work. Our Hands." Sunday. More details to follow in the coming weeks!
